### Type of Meeting: Board of Directors Meeting

- I. Call to order: 5:35 pm
- II. Roll call: All present
- III. Additions to, Deletions from, or Changes to the Agenda
- IV. Approval of minutes from last meeting: Director Bridges approves the agenda, Director Howe seconds.
- V. Committee Updates:
  - A. Operations Committee:
    1. Pioneer DGC:
      - a) Received tee signs but the attachment to the pole may not fit the pole. Discussed the possibility of using different posts or coming up with a different solution to attach them.
      - b) Baskets are in their final positions.
      - c) Discussed adding a flyer with a QR code that directs users to sign up to volunteer.
      - d) Date for a work day to cleanup course and tee-pads maintenance set for March 29th
    2. Cascades DGC
      - a) Date TBD for a work day to cut gong material and set gongs in ground on site.
  - B. Finance Committee:

1. Director McQuinn & Director Bridges met Monday, March 24 to review procedures and accounts. All accounts are now accessible to Director McQuinn.

#### C. Events Committee:

1. Handicap Plumas Series first event went well. Got good reviews from attendants.
2. Open Bag tags have shipped but Ladies tags status is unknown. Director Bridges will make sure they get shipped by Membership drive day or before. In case that doesn't happen, the open tags have duplicates for the first 5 tags so they could be used as place holders for Ladies tags.
3. September has been set as the "Tournament in a box" month. No specific date yet, nor a choice between Trilogy or MVP has been made.
4. There's requests to do more Glow rounds. Discussed having maybe one a quarter.

#### D. Outreach Committee

1. Farmer's Market Update & Rich Bar Basket Collab
  - a) Director Terhune updated the board on the possibility of the basket not being accessible during Farmer's market as it may be under a market booth or behind. Discussed the possibility of bowing out of farmers market or to do appearances when the market needs more vendors.
  - b) Discussion above brought the question about the basket installation. Director Terhune will reach out again to find out when that will happen. We will then discuss the return of the putting league.
